

### SB 105 Needs Your Support in the House of Representatives Agriculture & Small Business Committee

The Kentucky Horse Council supports SB 105 which, if passed, will create the Kentucky Livestock Care Commission. It is the belief of the Kentucky Horse Council that it is to the benefit of the livestock industry to self regulate. The creation of care standards by producers will ensure that the standards are attainable and appropriate.



Kentucky Senate Bill 105 is scheduled for a hearing in the Agriculture & Small Business Committee of the House of Representatives on March 3, 2010 at 8 a.m. in Room 129 of the Capital Annex Building.
