

Task Force Approves Strategic Plan for Kentucky Agriculture

(December, 2007) FRANKFORT, Ky. — In a meeting at the State Capitol Annex, the Task Force on the Future of Agriculture voted on December 17, 2007 to approve the draft strategic plan for Kentucky agriculture and handed off the document to the chair of the Kentucky Agricultural Council, Dr. Tony Brannon. The historic meeting of the Task Force ends a nine month process of creating a future plan for Kentucky agriculture and sets the stage for meeting the goals of increasing net farm income and improving the quality of life for rural communities.

The plan addresses 6 key topic areas with specific goals, actions and benchmarks for each one:

1. Agricultural Production and Consumer Marketing
2. AgriEnergy
3. Education
4. Public Awareness & Advocacy
5. Rural Communities: quality of life, conservation, and leadership development
6. Ag Development Fund and Supporting Governmental Actions
